Early Career Panel

Wyatt C. Stovall, Credit Analyst | CIT Bank, N.A.

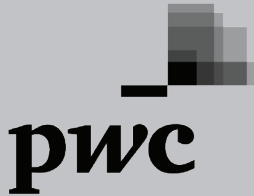
